Her producing credits include NAACP Image Award Nominees Making the Five Heartbeats. In the Hive, and a Sundance favorite Why We Laugh.



Lydia's extensive acting training includes being taught by acting gurus Stella Adler, Ivana Chubbuck, and Roy London who she studied under for over 8 years.




PRODUCER


Inspired by Goldie Hawn and Barbara Streisand, Lydia has been producing for over three decades. She started with actor showcases to get noticed by the industry.

Lydia has produced theater, live comedy shows, web series, television, and films, and she enjoys it all.


















COMEDIENNE

Lydia Nicole began doing stand-up comedy at a time when there weren't many females of color doing it. She was one of two Latinas in Los Angeles hitting the comedy clubs. In her first six months, the multifaceted singer-songwriter, musical director. Patrice Rushen hired Lydia to open for her and Ndugu Chancler. Two years later, Lydia joined forces with Cha Cha Sandoval-McMahon to form the multi-ethnic stand up show, "Funny Ladies of Color". The comediennes in the group included Karen Haber, Sherri Shepherd, Carlease Burke, Jackie Guerra, Dvana Ortelli, Alexis Rhee, Christy Medrano, and Lotus Weinstock.

A few years later Lydia went on to coproduce the first all Latina stand-up comedy show, The Hot & Spicy Mamitas, with Sully Diaz, Marilyn Martinez, Dyana Ortelli, and Ludo Vika. The Hot and Spicy Mamitas were an instant hit. They sold out shows everywhere they performed. They were signed by Uproar records and recorded an album by the same title.

Lydia was a regular at the World Famous Comedy Store and was listed as one of Hispanic Magazine's top 100 Latino Comedians.

Lydia has been speaking and motivating audiences for over three decades.

She is a true believer in encouraging others. Because of her background, Lydia was chosen by the head of publicity at Warner Brothers to go around the country and promote "Stand and Deliver". Soon after that, she became a main speaker for Athletes and Entertainers for Kids, where she spoke to thousands of students, from elementary, middle and high schools, including the Ryan White Aids Program, Kareem's Kids, and Kathy Ireland.

Lydia has been sought after by churches, colleges, organizations, and youth correctional facilities. She has also spoken at the DEA, the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences and SAG-AFTRA.

COMMON SENSE MAMITA


